

1. PROMOTION, PROTECTION AND PARTICIPATION OF CHILDREN AND ADOLESCENTS: Sustain achievements

From teamwork and networking, to technical assistance to the states, study of regulatory frameworks, exchange of practices, generation and support of networks of technical links, production of tools and intervention devices, processes training from the Inter-American Training Program, development of contents and communication strategies.

2. INNOVATION: Observatory of Public Policies for Children and Adolescents

Technical assistance to the states from an accumulated experience of public policies implemented in the continent, focusing on the observations made by the Committee on the Rights of the Boy and the Girl and with the participation of organizations of children and adolescents, based on networks with which the Institute works.

3. INCLUSIÓN: Articulation and networking

Integrate regional initiatives on issues of inclusion of children and adolescents with disabilities and the childhoods that, due to their condition, experience barriers to their participation (indigenous, migrant, afro-descendant, institutionalized children, and others) promoting exchange with specialized agencies for the approach to these situations.
