- (a) Managers persons within an organisation who primarily direct the organisation, а department or or subdivision of the organisation, supervise and control the work of other supervisory, professional or managerial employees, have the authority to hire and fire or recommend hiring, firing, or other personnel actions (such as promotion or authorisation), and exercise leave discretionary authority over day-to-day operations. Does not include first-line supervisors, unless the employees supervised are professionals, nor does it include employees who primarily perform tasks necessary for the provision of the service.
- (b) Executives persons within the organisation who primarily direct the management of the organisation, exercise wide latitude in decision-making, and receive only general supervision or direction from higher-level executives, the board of directors, or stockholders of the

requirements prevailing at the time of application.

Entry for these Intra-Corporate Transferees is limited to a three-year period that may be extended for up to 2 (two) additional years, for a total term not exceeding 5 (five) years.

For greater certainty, the extension period is subject to approval, and is subject to the eligibility requirements prevailing at the time of application of extension.
