#### SECTION I

### (THRESHOLD ADJUSTMENT FORMULA)

- 1. The thresholds for the procurement of goods and services by entities listed in Sections A through C, and the thresholds for procurement of construction services by entities listed in Sections A through C shall be adjusted in every even-numbered year with each adjustment taking effect on January 1, beginning on January 1 of the first even-numbered year after the date of entry into force of this Agreement for Singapore.
- 2. The adjustments shall be based on the average of the daily conversion rates of the Singapore currency in terms of the Special Drawing Rights (SDR), published by the International Monetary Fund in its monthly *International Financial Statistics* over the two-year period preceding October 1 or November 1 of the year prior to the thresholds in Singapore currency becoming effective which will be from January 1.
- 3. Singapore shall consult if a major change in its national currency relative to the SDR or to the national currency of another Party were to create a significant problem with regard to the application of Chapter 13 (Government Procurement).
